Boat must be completely made out of cardboard. Plastic bags may be used to line inside or outside of boat.
 Boat does not have to be built during assigned time – but will be inspected by staff prior to competition
 Person or persons having a boat that floats the longest and can travel the assigned path given by staff will win.
 Person competing must be able to get inside boat and be contained within boat (i.e. – no feet hanging out bottom)
 Path of boat must be travelled by participant without any assistance. (oars or paddles are permitted)
 Boats are not allowed to be discarded at the beach after use – please take it back to your site.
